## T20 DIVISION ONE - SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER 2018

## THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AND RULES SHALL APPLY:

Loss

1. Points shall be awarded in the Group Stage as follows:

Win with Bonus Point\* 5
Win without Bonus Point 4
No Result / Abandoned 2 each

\*The team that achieves a Run Rate of 1.25 times that of the opposition shall be awarded 1 (one) bonus point. See

'Tournament Net Run Rate Calculation' Document at the foot of this Booklet. All points achieved in the 1<sup>st</sup> round will be carried forward to the second round.

- 2. If teams are equal in points, then the overall NRR will be used. If NRR is equal, the previous head to head match will be used. If still equal, then a coin toss will decide.
- 3. A maximum of 7 foreigners can be registered in each Squad. Foreign students studying in Maldives Schools are exempt.
- 4. A minimum of 9 players from each team are to be present 15 minutes before the scheduled match start time. The Toss is to be made 15 minutes prior to the scheduled match start time.

<sup>\*</sup>C.B.M. RESERVES THE RIGHT TO AMEND DATES AND TIMES AT ANY TIME. ANY CHANGES WILL BE COMMUNICATED PROMPTLY TO ALL RELEVANT PERSONS.

- 5. A team that is not present at the specified times above shall have 20% of their prize-money deducted at the conclusion of the tournament. The Team Manager and Captain will be referred to the C.B.M. Disciplinary Committee for potential punishment. Punishments include suspension from future C.B.M. Tournaments.
- 6. Registration of a Squad should be completed on the attached 'Squad Registration Form' along with written confirmation (by email to <a href="mailto:info@maldivescricket.org">info@maldivescricket.org</a>) to confirm which Tournament(s) a Club wishes to participate in. A formal acknowledgment from C.B.M. Officials will be emailed when the Tournament Committee has accepted the Application.
- 7. A maximum of 16 players can be named in a squad. Players' names can be added and removed from a squad in writing (by email to <a href="mailto:info@maldivescricket.org">info@maldivescricket.org</a>) no later than 24 hours before the scheduled start of play of the next fixture. A formal acknowledgment from C.B.M. Officials will be emailed when the Tournament Committee has accepted the change.
- 8. Individual Awards Criteria will be taken from all matches played in the tournament, including the Grand Final:

Best Batsman - Most runs scored

Best Bowler - Most wickets taken

Best Fielder - Points System: Catch - 5 points. Stumping - 3 points. Run Out (UnAssisted) - 2 points. Run Out (Assisted) - 1 point.

Most Valuable Player - 1<sup>st</sup> rank position in CricHQ > Leaderboards > M.V.P.

Most Promising Player – Highest ranked position in CricHQ > Leaderboards > M.V.P. \*Player must be born on or after 01.01.1995. i.e. an Under 23 player to be eligible for this award. A full explanation of M.V.P. CricHQ is at the foot of this Handbook.

- 9. Tournament & Match Scoring will be undertaken by C.B.M. Officials & staff using CricHQ software. Each club is welcome to take shared administration of their Club Page and Player List. Team and Individual statistics can be viewed and shared online and detailed Match Reports available. Live scoring of a match is available to view through a monthly subscription to CricHQ.
- 10. Unfortunately, a practice schedule for participating clubs cannot be distributed in advance. Should a club wish to have a practice session in either (i) Indoor Cricket Hall (ii) Outdoor Cricket Nets (iii) Within the boundary of Ekuveni Cricket Ground then please email <a href="mailto:info@maldivescricket.org">info@maldivescricket.org</a> no less than 72 hours before, stating the time and facility required. CBM Officials will reply within 24 hours with an answer. \*C.B.M. Tournament staff will always look for ways to facilitate club practices.
- 11. Should a National Squad player be a registered player of a Club, the respective National Squad Manager & Coach will be in communication with the Club Officials.
- 12. Playing Rules & Conditions will be taken from I.C.C. published 'Match Playing Conditions' incorporating the 2017 Code of the MCC Laws of Cricket. Any changes to these rules will be specific to each tournament and communicated in advance of the scheduled start of a match and to each Club Official.
- 13. A Captains Umpires Report is expected to be completed at the end of each match. This Report is to be handed to the Match coordinator no later than 1 hour after the end of a match. An example report is available at the foot of this Handbook.
- 14. All paid CBM full-time staff cannot play in the tournaments unless approved by CBM Management. Request to be sent by email to info@maldivescricket.org.
