

2023 MALDIVES T20 CHAMPIONSHIP

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AND RULES SHALL APPLY

1.	Points shall be awarded in the Group Stage as follows:		
	Win Point	3	
	Loss	0	
	Abandoned	1	

At the end of league:

- ★ If points are equal, the team with the most wins will be placed in the higher position.
- ★ If there are teams with equal points and equal wins, the team with the higher net run rate will be placed in the higher position.
- ★ If still equal, then the team with the higher number of wickets taken in the matches played in which results were achieved will be placed in the higher position.
- ★ If still equal then the team position will be determined by drawing lots.
- **2.** Winner of the 2023 Championship will automatically qualify to participate in the 2024 Maldives T20 Premier League competition.
- **3.** If a result is not achieved in a Semi-Final match, then the highest placed team at the conclusion of the Group Stage will progress to the Grand Final Match.
- **4.** A minimum of 9 players from each team are to be present 15 minutes before the scheduled match start time. The Toss is to be made 15 minutes prior to the scheduled match start time.



5. A team that is not present at the specified times above shall have a fine of MVR 500.00 per match at the conclusion of the tournament. The Team Manager and Captain will be referred to the C.B.M. Disciplinary Committee for potential reprimands.

REGISTRATION

- **6.** Registration of a Squad should be completed on the attached 'Squad Registration Form' along with written confirmation (by email to rizan@maldivescricket.org/ info@mldivescricket.org) to confirm which Tournament(s) a Club wishes to participate in. A formal acknowledgment from C.B.M. Officials will be emailed upon accepting the Application.
- **7.** A maximum of 18 players and 3 officials can be named in a squad. Players' names can be added and removed from a squad in writing (by email to rizan@maldivescricket.org / info@maldvescricket.org) no later than 12 hours before the scheduled start of the tournament.
 - **a.** A formal acknowledgment from C.B.M. Officials will be emailed when the Tournament Committee has accepted the change.
 - **b.** Player Replacement/Restrictions and Rankings; The following rules will be observed on the replacement of a player from a team
 - i. Any player who has played in the 2023 Maldives T20 Premier League will not be eligible to be registered as a squad player or take any active part of the playing XI.
 - **ii.** A registered player/member of any squad can be replaced upon presenting a valid medical report.
 - **iii.** A registered player/member of any squad can be replaced with a given valid reason with proven documents of a player's unavailability to continue the tournament. (other than medical scenarios)



- **iv.** Squad/Team Players who have not taken part in any of the matches can exchange Teams upon mutual agreement of the 2 clubs involved, prior to 12 hours of the match. Formal notice shall be sent to the CBM in writing or on mail at such occurrences.
- **v.** A replacement of an individual player can be done only once on himself. Hence once a player is replaced, he cannot take no further part in the tournament or exchange clubs for that matter.
- **vi.** Can register up to 4 foreign players under (business visa) and 2 players under (business visa) can play in a game.
- vii. There will be no player ranking.

OTHER RULES

- **8.** Tournament & Match Scoring will be undertaken by C.B.M. Officials & staff using CricClubs software. Each club is welcome to take shared administration of their Club Page and Player List.

 Team and Individual statistics can be viewed and shared online and detailed Match Reports available. Live scoring of a match is available to view through a monthly subscription to Cricclub.
- **9.** Unfortunately, a practice schedule for participating clubs cannot be distributed in advance. Should a club wish to have a practice session in either:
 - a. Indoor Cricket Hall
 - **b.** Outdoor Cricket Nets
 - c. Within the boundary of Ekuveni Cricket Ground



then please email <u>rizan@maldivescricket.org</u> / <u>info@maldiescricket.org</u> or contact CBM allocated staff to further proceed, stating the time and facility required. CBM Officials will reply within 24 hours with an answer.

C.B.M. Tournament staff will always look for ways to facilitate club practices.

- **10.** Playing Rules & Conditions will be taken from I.C.C. published 'T20 Match Playing Conditions' incorporating the 2023 Code of the MCC Laws of Cricket. Any changes to these rules will be specific to each tournament and communicated in advance of the scheduled start of a match and to each Club Official.
- **11.** Captains & Umpires Report is expected to be completed at the end of each match. This Report is to be handed to the Match coordinator no later than 1 hour after the end of a match.
