



Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of Indoor Cricket Hall Lockers

1. Lockers are assigned to cricket clubs, academies and players to store cricket bags and other cricketing equipment only.
2. Fees will be charged for the use of lockers according to the CBM Facilities Charge Sheet.
3. Lockers will be assigned according to the following criteria and on the basis of availability;
 - a. Official use of CBM
 - b. National team players (Players who are included in the national squad will be allocated a locker on their request for the period they are part of the team. This **will be given free of cost and on a sharing basis**)
 - c. Clubs – Each active CBM registered full member who has participated in at least 2 tournaments or cricket events in the previous year will be allocated a locker on their request and on payment of applicable fees.
 - d. Academies – Each active Cricket Academy will be allocated a locker upon their request and payment of applicable fees.
4. Lockers will be assigned upon receipt of a request in writing or by email and after payment of any applicable fees.
5. All lockers will be assigned on a yearly basis, with the possibility of extension based on the usage, cleanliness and responsibility of user.
6. Lockers will be assigned upon signing of a user agreement between CBM and the player/club/academy.
7. All existing users will have to formally sign a user agreement once these regulations come into effect.
8. In all cases, lockers are available on a first come, first served basis. In case there are more users than available lockers, CBM will select the eligible party by way of drawing a lot.
9. Users who have built their own lockers, will have first right of use upon renewing of agreement and payment of fees. However, all lockers will remain the property of CBM.
10. Storage of any items that would cause or likely to cause safety risk, physical danger or nuisance to the environment or other members using indoor facilities are prohibited.



11. Cricket Board of Maldives will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any items stored inside the lockers. All users must take full responsibility for the items stored in their lockers.
12. Those who have been assigned a locker should ensure that it is properly locked at all times.
13. All users should leave a spare key with CBM office for use in emergencies and for safety purposes.
14. Lockers cannot be transferred or changed without approval from CBM.
15. Unauthorized use of locker is not permitted.
16. An annual fee for the lockers/locker usage will be charged to the clubs. (The rates and charges sheet is annexed with the agreement. Annex 01)
17. CBM reserves the right to, without notifying the user in advance, open any locker in case of emergency or any violation of the above regulations.
18. Any violation of these regulations may result in termination of use of the locker facility.
19. All existing users will have to formally sign a user agreement once these regulations come into effect.

Notes:

- All facilities will be allocated on availability basis.
- Priority will be given for national team and national squads.
- For net and ground use, booking must be made at least one day in advance.
- For match and tournament use, booking must be made at least a week in advance.
- For other facilities bookings should be made at least 3 days in advance.
- Lockers will be assigned as per CBM locker use agreement with users.
- For member club's free usage will be limited to the club registered 15 players including officials.
- **Only hardball cricket can be played in the Indoor Cricket Hall. Exception will be made for teams preparing for Ramadan Cricket Carnival, and with written approval from CBM.**
