GUIDELINES

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AND RULES SHALL APPLY

1. Points shall be awarded for each match:

Win Point	3
Loss	0
Draw	1
2. End of league matches
 - a 2 team with most points will play a one off final.
 - b If points are equal - higher net run rate will qualify
 - c If still equal (head to head winner qualify)
 - d If still equal - toss of coin.
3. Restriction on Business Visa players.
 - a Only 6 players can be registered.
 - b Only 4 players can play at a time.
 - c Must play in a league match to qualify to play in the final.
4. A minimum of 9 players from each team are to be present 15 minutes before the scheduled match start time. The Toss is to be made 30-15 minutes prior to the scheduled match start time.
5. **A team that is not present at the specified times above shall have 20% fine on participation allowance.** The Team Manager and Captain will be referred to the C.B.M. Disciplinary Committee.
6. Registration of a Squad.
 - a 20 players can be registered.
 - b Manager and Captain to be marked.
7. A registered player/member of any squad can be replaced only upon presenting a valid medical report or in accordance with the ICC guideline for the same.
8. Tournament & Match Scoring will be undertaken by C.B.M. Officials & staff using Cricclub software. Each club is welcome to take shared administration of their Club Page and Player List. Team and Individual statistics can be viewed and shared online and detailed Match Reports available. Live scoring of a match is available to view through a monthly subscription to Cricclub.
9. Playing Rules & Conditions will be taken from I.C.C. published 'ODI Match Playing Conditions' incorporating the 2023 Code of the MCC Laws of Cricket. Any changes



to these rules will be specific to each tournament and communicated in advance of the scheduled start of a match and to each Club Official.

10. A Captains & Umpires Report is expected to be completed at the end of each match. This Report is to be handed to the Match coordinator no later than 1 hour after the end of a match.
11. Two new balls will be used in each innings.
12. Substitution can be done at any time of the innings, this can be done among the registered members only.
 - a Not more than 11 players can be on the field at any time of the innings.
 - b Not more than 11 batters can bat in the allocated 50 overs.
